## JOIN THE COMMUNITY

*A community of people* – We know from experience that community works through connection and trust between people. Following this, Hub members are people that represent the organisations they are working for, not organisations. Members have access to the services and benefits of the Humanity Hub and in doing so activate the benefits for their organisation.

It is important to understand the principle of *members are people*, so that members and their organisations can make the best choice on how to engage in our community.

Membership at the Humanity Hub gives access to a diverse and rich community of professionals working towards a peaceful and just world, from The Hague and beyond.

Hub members work across a variety of sectors and causes. Through the Hub, they can find new opportunities to connect, share knowledge and collaborate with like-minded people.

### Individual Membership Subscriptions

Available for any qualified organisation from 1 membership.

Individual membership is required for the use of residency services (co-working or private office services).

### Organisational membership subscriptions (non-resident)

For organisations that do not wish to use the Humanity Hub's residency services (co-working or private office services), memberships can be purchased as an annual subscription:

### Good to know:

- Individual membership subscriptions are based on a 12-month contract with a 1-month termination clause and invoiced quarterly in advance.
- Organisational membership subscriptions are based on a 12-month subscription and are invoiced annually.
- Individual memberships can be added or discontinued with one calendar month notice.
- Memberships can be transferred to another employee during the subscription.
- Membership benefits and services are available to members only.
- Members can invite guests to the Hub café or landing space. These can be colleagues or others.
- Guests must be accompanied by a member.

## MAKE THE HUB YOUR OFFICE (HUB RESIDENCY)

Exclusively for Hub members, we offer a variety of flexible office services. Below you can find details on co-working, private offices, virtual office, and locker storage.

### Co-working

You can also choose to use the Hub as your flexible office by adding co-working rights to your membership. Co-working rights entitle you to use any of the co-working spaces including conversation spaces, silent room and phone booths on the 2nd, 3rd, or 4th floors at the Hub City Centre location.

## Virtual office

(membership + business address)

If your organisation wants to establish itself in The Hague, we offer virtual office services which include one Hub membership and the usage of The Hague Humanity Hub's address as a business address.

The business address service includes:

- Use of business address at **The Hague Humanity Hub, Fluwelen Burgwal 58**
- Receiving mail and parcels, storing them at the reception until retrieval by the member or a person delegated by the member.

The total cost of the package is 92€ per month<sup>5</sup>

## Private Offices

- Hub Flex 1 residency includes a 30% discount on the hourly rate of small and medium meeting spaces at the Hub Central location.
- Hub Flex 3, Hub Flex 24/7, and Dedicated Desk residency include a 40% discount on the hourly rate of small and medium, and a 10% discount on the hourly rate of large meeting spaces at the Hub Central location.
