Individual Membership Subscription

€ 42,00 / person per month²

Available for any registered organisation from 1 membership. Individual membership is required for the use of residency services (co-working or private office services).

Organisational Membership Subscriptions

For organisations that do not wish to use the Humanity Hub's residency services (co-working or private office services) and would like to register 5> members at once, you may consider the annual subscription:

About the membership plans:

- Individual membership subscriptions are based on a 12-month contract with a one calendar month termination clause and invoiced monthly in advance.
- Organisational membership subscriptions are based on a 12-month subscription and are invoiced annually.
- Memberships can be transferred to another employee during the subscription.
- Membership benefits and services are available to members only.
- Members can invite guests to the Hub café or landing space.
- Guests must be always accompanied by a registered member.
- Subscriptions are subject to The Hague Humanity Hub General Terms and Conditions.

MAKE THE HUB YOUR OFFICE (HUB RESIDENCY)

Exclusively for Hub members, we offer a variety of flexible office services. Below you can find details on co-working, private offices, virtual office, and locker storage.

Co-working

Use the Hub as your flexible office by adding co-working rights to your membership. Co-working rights entitle you to use any of the co-working spaces including conversation spaces, silent room and phone booths on the 2nd, 3rd, or 4th floors at the Hub.

Virtual office

(membership + business address)

If your organisation wants to establish itself in The Hague, we offer virtual office services which include one Hub membership and the usage of The Hague Humanity Hub's address as a business address.

The business address service includes:

- Use of business address at The Hague Humanity Hub, Fluwelen Burgwal 58
- Receiving mail and parcels, storing them at the reception until retrieval by the member or a person delegated by the member.

The total cost of the package is 100€4 per month

Private Offices

Meeting room discounts for Hub members

- Hub Members and those with Shared Co-working bundle have 20% discount on the hourly rate of small and medium meeting spaces at the Hub.
- Hub Flex 1 residents have 30% discount on the hourly rate of small and medium meeting spaces at the Hub.
- Hub Flex 3, Hub Flex 24/7, and Dedicated Desk residents have 40% discount on the hourly rate of small and medium, and a 10% discount on the hourly rate of large meeting spaces at the Hub.
- Hub Members have free AV use in all meeting and event spaces.
